6. Presidential Address

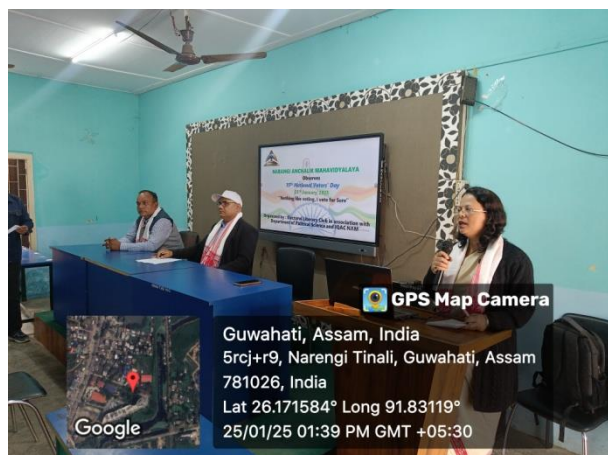

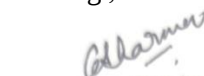
Conclusion
