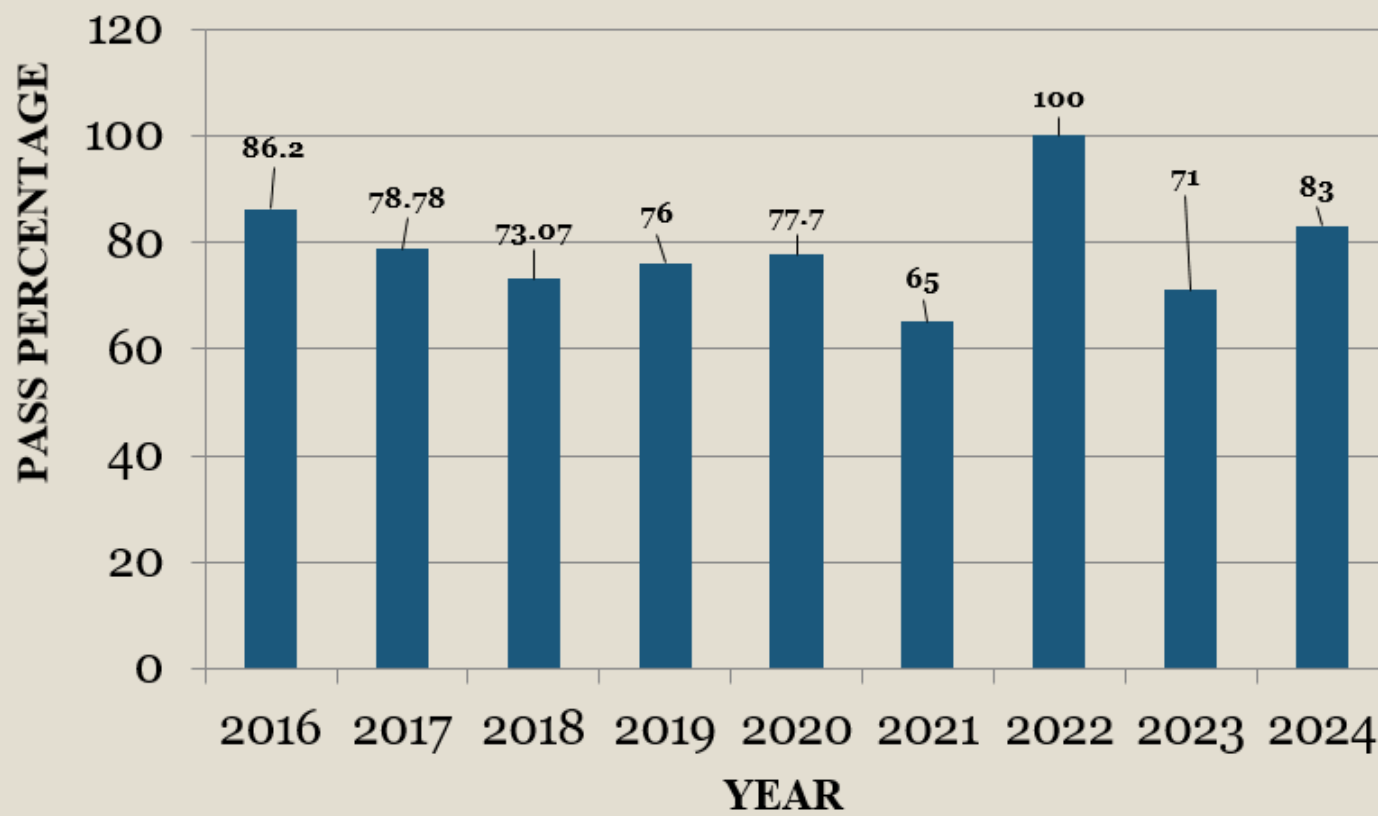
PASS PERCENTAGE IN ECONOMICS HONOURS

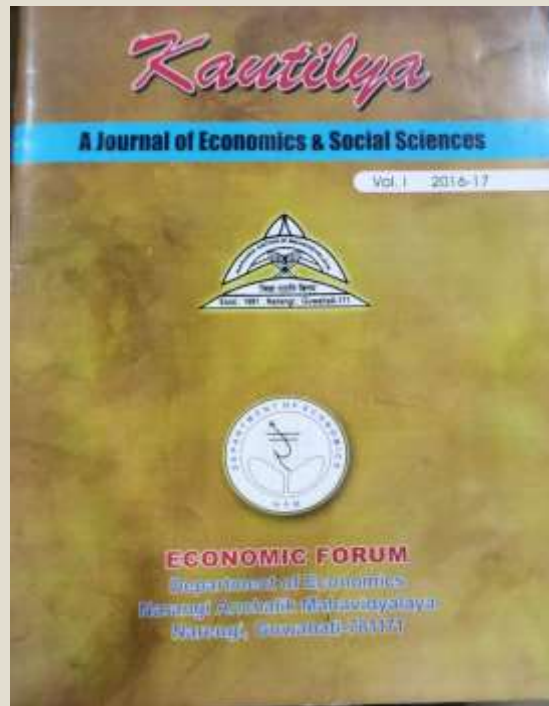

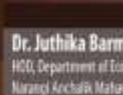
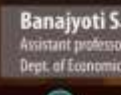
